

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
REEDS SPRING BAND BOOSTER CLUB

The undersigned, being natural persons of the age of eighteen years or more, and citizens of the United States, for the purpose of forming a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Missouri, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1

The name of the corporation is: Reeds Spring Band Booster Club.

ARTICLE 2

This corporation is a Public Benefit Corporation.

ARTICLE 3

The period of the duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE 4

The street address of the Registered Office in Missouri is 20277 State Highway 413, Reeds Spring, MO 65737, in Stone County, and the name of the initial Registered Agent is Paulette Pearce.

ARTICLE 5

The name and address of each incorporator is as follows: Paulette Pearce, 70 Melody Manor Lane, Reeds Spring, MO 65737, and Molly Turner, 24 Village Trail 21-5, Branson, MO 65616.

ARTICLE 6

The corporation does have members.

ARTICLE 7

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed to the Reeds Spring School Band program within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 8

The corporation is formed exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The corporation is organized for the purpose of assisting the band director to promote, encourage, support and sponsor activities of the band, through the supplementing of existing financial programs and by any other means approved by the members.

ARTICLE 9

No part of the earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

ARTICLE 10

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in, including publishing or distribution of statements, in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE 11

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE 12

The effective date of this document is the date it is filed by the Secretary of State of Missouri.
